The 1969 Society of Cosmetic Chemists Award sponsored by International Flavors and Fragrances, Inc., has been presented to Dr. Leszek J. Wolfram of the Gillette Research Institute for his paper "Modification of Hair by Internal Deposition of Polymers" and to Dr. A. Bernard Ackerman of the University of Miami School of Medicine and Dr. Albert M. Kligman of the University of Pennsylvania Dept. of Dermatology for their paper "Some Observations on Dandruff."

The award, consisting of a scroll and a \$1000 honorarium, is presented annually to the author or authors of the most meritorious paper published in the JOURNAL OF THE SOCIETY OF COSMETIC CHEMISTS, U.S.A. Formal presentation was made by the Society's President, Mr. Charles Fox, Warner Lambert Research Institute, at the December 1st luncheon session during the Society's annual meeting at the Americana Hotel (New York City).
